

How To Start A Home Study Group

1. Invite other individuals to your home on the Sabbath, which is Saturday; but this can also be on Sunday or any other time during the week for coming together as a group to study the Holy Book of God (the Scriptures/Peshitta) and the Didache.
2. It would be good to start your study time with prayer and a few minutes of meditational music, personally sung as a group or using pre-recorded music, so that those in attendance can prepare their minds for study and worshiping Yeshua.
3. Have the majority of the time centered on the Word of God, the Peshitta, also study the Didache. Read, study, and ask questions of each other. Assign someone to lead the group. It would be his/her responsibility to outline what it to be discussed each time the group meets and to lead the discussions. Do not allow "lecture style" study, but interactive study. Rely on God as your Guide.
4. Always let God's Presence lead you.
5. Remember that Yeshua will be present so keep your study time organized and most importantly reverent.
6. Conclude the session with prayer asking the Lord to bless the week and days ahead.
7. Do not be a "clock watcher" keeping your study and worship time to an exact period of time. Obviously you do not want the session to go beyond a reasonable time frame but likewise if the Lord is guiding your study, which we always pray would be the case, you don't want to simply stop because an hour has already gone by. Stopping an enlightening study session before it is time would not be a wise thing to do since the purpose of your gathering together was to realize the Lord's Presence and obtain His blessing. God does not operate according to our time but to His.
